From the Vicarage

If you are a Christian, then at some point in your life you have already responded to God's call in your life. That initial call was to know God in Jesus, and to live the life of a disciple, a life worked out in community with the body of Christ, the church.

Some people – and you may be one of them – at some point on the journey sense a further call of God. This *vocation* (from Latin, meaning 'a call') may be very specific, or it could be simply a sense of wanting to step out in faith to explore where God might lead.

Vocation is not necessarily to ordained ministry, although it could be. Vocation can be many things: a call to prayer or to sharing faith with others; a call to live out being a Christian at work or at home; a call to contemplation, or to using a particular talent in the service of God.

You may like to use 1 Corinthians 12: 12-27 for prayer and reflection as you consider God's calling in your life.

If you would like to explore the issue of vocation (or calling) further, please come with me to the *Vocations Roadshow* on Sunday 13 July (more details in this newsletter). If you would like to talk to someone about your own sense of calling, please ask and I will put you in contact with a Vocations Adviser in the diocese.
