From the Vicarage

There's sometimes a bit of misunderstanding about the *church electoral roll*, so here is a short explanation. There is more information on the parish website.

Our *church electoral roll* is different from the local register of electors compiled by the Council. If your name appears on the *church electoral roll*, you are entitled to attend the Annual Parish Meeting, to vote and to stand for office, e.g. as a Churchwarden or a Parochial Church Council representative.

To go on the *church electoral roll*, you need to be baptised in the C of E, 16 years of age or over, residing in the parish (or habitually worshipping in the parish church during the previous six months).

The Church of England doesn't have a formal membership system as some churches do, so the church electoral roll is sometimes used as a membership list. We encourage everyone who regularly worships in one of our four churches to join the electoral roll for the parish. It is a formal way of saying that you belong.
