From the Vicarage

At our Annual Church Meeting in April, we took the following words as our parish Bible verse for the year ahead:

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. (1 Peter 2:9)

The writer - Peter, a close friend of Jesus - is encouraging those who trust in Jesus to understand themselves in a new way. He uses the images of *a race, a nation, and a people*, to show how believing in Jesus draws people together into belonging to one another and into a community. The second part of the verse gives the reason why - **so that God's** actions in the lives of his people can be made known in his world. This verse carefully sums **up the life and purpose and calling of God's people, the church.**

Please take some time to think and pray about this verse as we work and worship together through this year.
