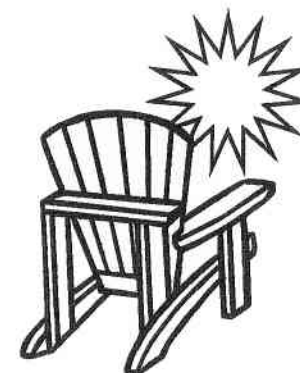

Dealing with Debt and Money Problems

The financial problems in the world have affected all of us. For people who were only just managing financially before, the increased pressure may have taken them into debt, however hard they work or however carefully they manage their money. Debt problems can damage family relationships and may cause ill health or even homelessness.

Help is available. Recently, a national Christian based organisation, **Hope Debt Advice**, has set up an office in Masham to serve the Dales. This is a free and confidential service, available to anyone who contacts them, and they will come to your home. I have met them and seen their work, and I am very impressed with the professional, confidential nature of the way that they help people to take control of their lives again.

If you or someone you know needs this help, you can contact **Hope Debt Advice** yourself and deal with them directly. Or, if you prefer, you can go through me; I can make the initial contact for you and be present at the meetings to support you if you want that.
